## Bring Your Own Device (B. Y. O. D.) Agreement Paringa Park Primary School

Our school has embraced a Bring Your Own Technology/Device approach to enhancing the use of technology for our students and teachers.

Electronic devices are used to promote genuine learning, research and positive communication. We support our students to become digitally responsible citizens.

Please review and sign the B. Y. O. D. agreement between teachers, parents, and students of Paringa Park Primary School. No student will be permitted to use a personal technology device until the agreement is signed and returned. A device is defined as any technology that students would like to use to facilitate word processing, capturing video and recording audio, accessing the internet, and processing information.

Students participating in the B. Y. O. D. must adhere to the Acceptable Use Policy of Paringa Park Primary School. Please read the following statements carefully:

- 1. Students take full responsibility for their devices. The school is NOT responsible for security of personal technology. Personal devices cannot be left before or after school hours. Students are also responsible for the insurance of personal devices.
- 2. Devices cannot be used outside the classroom, unless otherwise directed by the teacher.
- 3. Students must immediately comply with teachers' requests to shut down devices or close the screen. Devices must be in silent mode and put away when asked by the teacher.
- 4. Students are not permitted to transmit or post photographic images/videos or audio of any person at school on public and/or social networks.
- 5. Personal devices must be charged prior to bringing them to school and run off their own batteries while at school.
- 6. To ensure appropriate network filters, students will only use the BYOD wireless connection in school and 3G and 4G access will be turned off during school hours.
- 7. Paringa Park Primary School has the right to collect and examine any device.
- 8. Students realize that printing from personal devices will not be permitted at school.
- 9. Students will not share their personal devices with other students. Only the student that brings the device may use the device.
- 10. Students will be responsible for keeping their personal device secure while at school.
